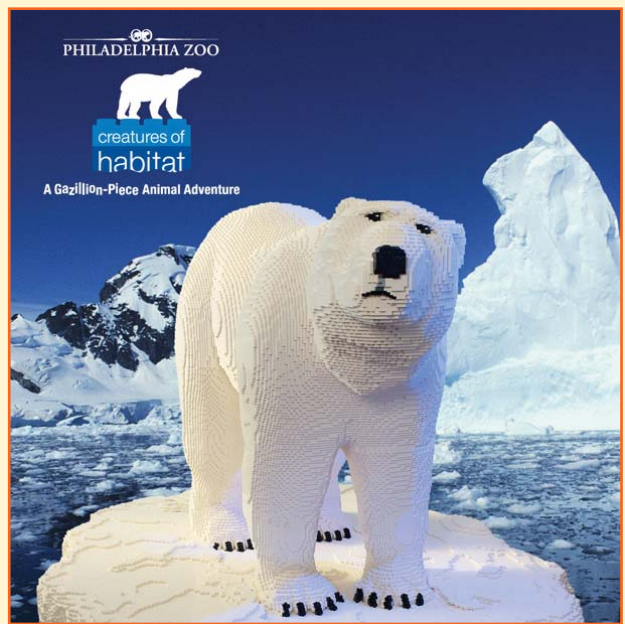

Important information about electric market changes

Restructuring has transformed PECO from a company that *made* electricity and delivered it to our customers, to a company that now *purchases* electricity and delivers it to customers through our neighborhood poles and wires. During this period of transition, prices remained set, regardless of what prices were doing in the marketplace. The capped rates will come to an end in January 2011. After January 1, 2011, the prices of electricity and natural gas will be based on market prices.

The costs to operate our electric and natural gas systems also have increased. Because of this, in March 2010 PECO requested Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) approval to increase electric delivery rates and natural gas delivery rates beginning January 1, 2011.

The first electric delivery rate request and only the second natural gas delivery rate request in about 20 years, the increases will ensure PECO is able to continue to meet customer demand and ensure the safe and reliable delivery of electricity and natural gas.

We know that we have an obligation to help customers manage this change. Customers can offset much of the increase that will happen at the beginning of 2011 by finding ways to use less energy. Using less energy will save you money and also helps the environment.
