
On January 14, 2010, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed the results of its Request for Proposals (RFP) Process and Rules, including the proposed bid results from its January 2010 solicitation for delivery of 8,000 solar Tier I alternative energy credits annually to satisfy a portion of PECO's solar-related future Alternative Energy Portfolio Standard Act requirements, for a ten-year period beginning January 1, 2011, at Docket No. P-2009-2094494.

This filing is submitted in accordance to the RFP Process and Rules filed by PECO on March 3, 2009, as modified by the Commission's Order entered August 28, 2009 approving the Joint Petition for Settlement filed July 2, 2009.

PECO requests that the Commission approve the process results from the January 2010 solicitation on or before January 25, 2010.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the January 2010 solicitation appears to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules filed pursuant to the Commission's Orders. Therefore, we approve the bid results submitted for the January 2010 Solar RFP process. However, any winning bid results, submitted for a facility that is not yet certified as a facility qualified to deliver alternative energy portfolio credits, are approved conditioned upon the facility receiving certification as a qualify facility prior to the date the credits are to be delivered by the facility.
