## Electric Rates to Change Beginning December 1, 2022

Beginning with service provided December 1, 2022, changes will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, these changes result in a total increase of \$8.85 to the typical monthly bill, from \$122.77 to \$131.62, or 7.21%. The enclosed bill reflects these changes. Here are the details:

### **Generation Charges:**

The costs to purchase electricity are passed along to customers at exactly the prices that PECO pays. The generation charges for residential customers will increase by 1.348 cents to 9.128 cents per kWh.

- The charge is \$63.90 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month.

The generation charges for small commercial customers will increase by 1.514 cents to 8.881 cents per kWh.

- The charge is \$888.10 per month for a typical small commercial customer using 10,000 kWh of electricity per month.

**Transmission Charges:** The Transmission Service Charge (TSC) for residential customers will decrease by 0.001 cents to 0.727 cents per kWh. The TSC is \$5.09 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The TSC for small commercial customers will increase by \$0.07 to \$1.82/kWh. The TSC for large commercial customers will increase by \$0.82 to \$2.02/kWh.

**Distribution Charges:** The distribution charge includes the Non-Bypassable Transmission Service Charge (NBT) which recovers certain regional power grid charges from all distribution customers. The NBT charge for residential customers will decrease by 0.083 cents to 0.345 cents per kWh. The NBT is \$2.42 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The NBT charge for small commercial customers will decrease by \$0.18 to \$0.89/kWh. The NBT charge for large commercial customers will decrease by \$0.19 to \$1.06/kWh.

\* State Tax Adjustment applies to the Customer Charge and Distribution Charges.

Customers who purchase the electricity they use from a competitive electric generation supplier would not pay PECO's Generation and Transmission Charges listed above. Instead, they would pay the charges of the competitive electric generation supplier they have chosen.
