## Electric Rates to Change Beginning January 1, 2023

Beginning with service provided January 1, 2023, changes will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, these changes result in a total increase of \$1.76 to the typical monthly bill, from \$131.62 to \$133.38, or 1.34%. The enclosed bill reflects these changes. Here are the details:

**Universal Service Fund Charge (USFC):** This charge recovers the costs associated with PECO's low-income programs. The USFC is changing from a credit value of 0.175 cents per kWh to a charge value of 0.085 cents per kWh. For a typical residential customer using 700 kWh per month, the new rate will result in an increase of \$1.82 per month, which is included in the Distribution Charges.

**State Tax Adjustment:** The State Tax Adjustment Surcharge (STA) will decrease from a credit value of 0.01% to a credit value of 0.11%. This charge will result in a \$0.06 decrease per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh per month.
