## Electric Rates to Change Beginning April 1, 2023

Beginning with service provided April 1, 2023, changes will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, this results in a total increase of \$0.05 to the typical monthly bill, from \$132.47 to \$132.52, or 0.04%. The enclosed bill reflects this change. Here are the details:

### **Consumer Education Plan Costs:**

PECO's Consumer Education Plan helps educate customers on Pennsylvania's competitive energy market. The plan includes certain costs approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PAPUC). The impact of these changes on the Customer Charge is:

- Rate R (Residential Service), Rate RH (Residential Heating Service) and CAP (Customer Assistance Program) is increasing by one cent to \$10.52.
- Rate GS (General Service) will remain a rate of zero cents.
- Rate HT (High Tension) will decrease by three cents to \$353.84.
- Rate PD (Primary Distribution) will decrease by three cents to \$295.94.

### **Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC):**

The DSIC, which is shown as a separate line item on your bill, allows PECO to accelerate the modernization of the distribution system through the installation, replacement and relocation of electric equipment and facilities. The DSIC will increase from a value of 0% to a value of 0.06%. This change will result in an increase of \$0.04 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh per month. This change will result in an increase of \$0.15 per month for a typical small commercial customer and an increase of \$2.07 for a typical large commercial customer.

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge per month will be the Customer Charge. State Tax Adjustment applies to this rate.

\* State Tax Adjustment applies to the Customer Charge and Distribution Charges.

\*\* For calculating the DSIC \$0.00285/kWh is removed from the Distribution Charges.

Customers who purchase the electricity they use from a competitive electric generation supplier would not pay PECO's Generation and Transmission Charges listed above. Instead, they would pay the charges of the competitive electric generation supplier they have chosen.
