

GAS RATES TO CHANGE BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2023

Beginning with service provided April 1, 2023, changes will affect your monthly gas bill. For a residential customer using 80 cubic feet (Ccf) per month, the effect of these approved changes is a total increase of \$0.19 to the typical monthly bill, from \$110.78 to \$110.97, or 0.17%. For a commercial customer (Rate GC – General Service – Commercial and Industrial) using 400 Ccf per month, the bill will increase by \$0.68, from \$475.09 to \$475.77, or 0.14%. The enclosed bill reflects these changes. The details are explained below.

Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC):

The DSIC, which is shown as a separate line item on your bill, allows PECO to accelerate the modernization of the distribution system through the installation, replacement and relocation of gas equipment and facilities. The DSIC will increase from a value of 0.0% to a value of 0.33%. This change will result in a \$0.19 increase on the monthly bill for a typical residential customer using 80 Ccf of gas per month and a \$0.68 increase on the monthly bill for a commercial customer using 400 Ccf per month.
