

Electric Rates to Change Beginning March 1, 2022

Beginning with service provided March 1, 2022, changes will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, this results in a total increase of \$0.30 to the typical monthly bill, from \$111.40 to \$111.70, or 0.27%. The enclosed bill reflects this change. Here are the details:

Generation Charges:

The costs to purchase electricity are passed along to customers at exactly the prices that PECO pays. The generation charges for residential customers will increase by 0.043 cents to 6.433 cents per kWh.

- The charge is \$45.03 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month.

The generation charges for small commercial customers will increase by 0.597 cents to 6.346 cents per kWh.

- The charge is \$634.60 per month for a typical small commercial customer using 10,000 kWh of electricity per month.

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge per month will be the Customer Charge. State Tax Adjustment applies to this rate.
