THREE EASY WAYS TO LOWER YOUR ENERGY BILL

1. KEEP TRACK OF YOUR THERMOSTAT—Save up to 10% on your heating bill by simply turning your thermostat back 7°–10°F for eight hours a day from its normal setting. Save even more by installing a programmable thermostat and maintaining those settings.

2. CHECK FOR HIDDEN LEAKS—Check for air leaks around plumbing vents, attic hatch, recessed lights. When windows are closed, locking them helps prevent drafts. Seal all the gaps where air can leak in or out.


3. INSPECT YOUR ATTIC—Check for air leaks around attic access and throughout your attic. Check for adequate attic insulation.
