

# ELECTRIC RATES TO CHANGE BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2021

Beginning with service provided March 1, 2021, the following change will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, the effect of this approved change is a total decrease of \$1.11 to the typical monthly bill, from \$101.40 to \$100.29 or 1.09%. The enclosed bill reflects this change. Here are the details:

**Generation Charges:** The costs to purchase electricity are passed along to customers at exactly the prices that PECO pays. The generation charges for residential customers will decrease by 0.159 cents to 5.761 cents per kWh beginning March 1, 2021. The charge is \$40.33 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The generation charges for small commercial customers will decrease by 0.765 cents to 5.243 cents per kWh. The charge is \$524.30 per month for a typical small commercial customer using 10,000 kWh of electricity per month.

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge per month will be the Customer Charge. State Tax Adjustment applies to this rate.

\*\* For calculating the DSIC \$0.00273/kWh is removed from the Distribution Charges.
