PECO NATURAL GAS: SAFE, RELIABLE, AFFORDABLE

PECO works hard to ensure safe, reliable, affordable and clean energy for more than 529,000 natural gas customers. We maintain approximately 13,000 miles of natural gas transmission, distribution, and service lines in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Lancaster counties. In addition, PECO responds to reports of natural gas odors in less than an hour—99.9 percent of the time—which is one of the best response times among Pennsylvania natural gas utilities.

The Benjamin Franklin Bridge is a suspension bridge across the Delaware River, connecting Philadelphia, PA to Camden, NJ. One of four bridges operated by the Delaware River Port Authority, the bridge was opened to traffic on July 1, 1926. The 7,456-foot span provides three modes of transportation, including seven vehicular lanes, the PATCO transit line and a pedestrian walkway.
