



## EV Charging Pilot Now Running

**PECO's Level 2 Commercial EV Pilot** is designed to incentivize the build out of EV charging infrastructure by offsetting eligible make-ready costs. Customers can receive rebates for up to 20 ports.

The pilot features two rebate levels:

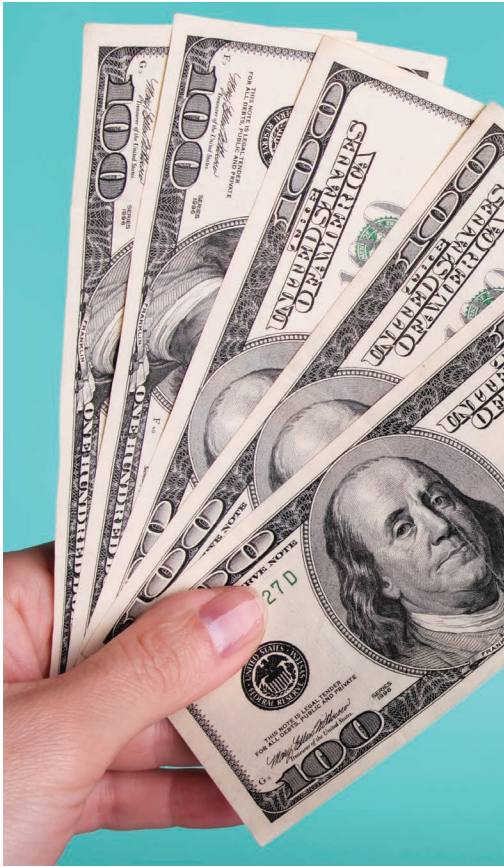
- 1. Lesser of \$2,000 per port or 50%** of make-ready costs for projects located within PECO Electric Service Territory
- 2. Lesser of \$3,000 per port or 75%** of make-ready costs for projects located within PECO Electric Service Territory AND Environmental Justice Areas

Other Important Information:

- Customers are required to apply prior to the start of charging station projects.

- Program incentives are available to eligible commercial and industrial customers who shop for electric generation supply.
- Customers receiving rebates must provide data from the EV charger(s) for two years.
- Governmental incentives such as those offered by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) through their Driving PA Forward (for more details, visit [bit.ly/drivingpa](https://bit.ly/drivingpa)) and Alternative Fuel Incentive Grant programs can be combined with this rebate as long as all incentives do not exceed the total project costs.
- Funds are limited and subject to availability.

# Gas Grants available for Commercial Natural Gas Customers— Apply Now

**Small businesses affected by the pandemic can now apply to receive a one-time grant of \$500** towards their existing PECO natural gas account. The grant will be applied directly to your bill and will lower current outstanding balances or provide a credit for future charges.

## Criteria

To be eligible, applicants must have an active PECO gas account on or before March 31, 2020, take service under Rate GC (gas commercial service), have fewer than 25 employees, and have experienced financial hardship resulting from the pandemic. Each commercial gas business is eligible for only one grant, regardless of the number of gas accounts listed under the business name.

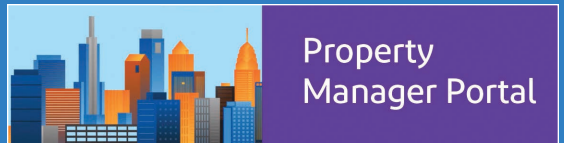
