

ELECTRIC RATES TO CHANGE BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 2021

Beginning with service provided December 1, 2021, changes will affect your monthly electric bill. For a residential customer using 700 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, the effect of these approved changes is a total increase of \$2.94 to the typical monthly bill, from \$102.07 to \$105.01, or 2.88%. The enclosed bill reflects this change. Here are the details:

Generation Charges: The costs to purchase electricity are passed along to customers at exactly the prices that PECO pays. The generation charges for residential customers will increase by 0.376 cents to 6.388 cents per kWh. The charge is \$44.72 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The generation charges for small commercial customers will increase by 0.441 cents to 5.747 cents per kWh. The charge is \$574.70 per month for a typical small commercial customer using 10,000 kWh of electricity per month.

Transmission Charges: The Transmission Service Charge (TSC) for residential customers will increase by 0.048 cents to 0.633 cents per kWh. The TSC is \$4.43 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The TSC for small commercial customers will decrease by \$0.03 to \$1.21/kWh. The TSC for large commercial customers will increase by \$0.11 to \$1.19/kWh.

Distribution Charges: The distribution charge includes the Non-Bypassable Transmission Service Charge (NBT) which recovers certain regional power grid charges from all distribution customers. The NBT charge for residential customers will decrease by 0.004 cents to 0.326 cents per kWh. The NBT is \$2.28 per month for a typical residential customer using 700 kWh of electricity per month. The NBT charge for small commercial customers will decrease by \$0.04 to \$0.69/kWh. The NBT charge for large commercial customers will increase by \$0.07 to \$0.94/kWh.
