

# LOOKING TO SAVE ENERGY AND MONEY?

## *Start with the break room*

- 1 Use ENERGY STAR® appliances.** Do you have a refrigerator or dishwasher in your break room? Upgrade to energy-efficient models when it's time to replace them.
- 2 Eliminate the water cooler.** Instead, invest in a water filter cooler for the fridge. Tap water is generally less expensive than bottled or a free-standing filtration system.
- 3 Switch off appliances at the end of the day.** Even if they're not running, they're sucking up power. Connecting appliances to a power strip makes this easy, because with the touch of a single switch, you can power down everything on the circuit. If you have a microwave, toaster, coffee maker, or similar appliances, this is one way to cut down on phantom energy drain.
- 4 Use sensor-activated lights.** You might not need to have lights on all the time. Let sensors turn the lights on when someone enters, then turn off after a specific amount of time.
- 5 Cut down on vending machines.** Do you know how much it costs to run a refrigerated beverage machine? It could be \$300–\$500



per year. If you're leasing the machine, this can get even more expensive. If just a handful of employees are using the machine, removing it could save money without a huge impact. Provide reusable drink containers and encourage employees to bring drinks from home.
